

CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUE OF LONG-STAY PARKING PERMITS

1. The applicant will be the permit holder who shall certify that they are the owner of, or an employee of a business with premises in Arnold Town Centre. Arnold Town Centre shall mean the area indicated on the plan attached to these conditions.
2. The permit holder may park lawfully displaying a permit in any of the six public car parks in Arnold Town Centre only. The car parks referred to are set out in The First Schedule Part I of The Gedling Borough Council (off street parking places short stay) Order 2001.
3. The permit does not guarantee a parking space will be available at any time.
4. The fee for the permit will be £70.00 (including VAT) per quarter, reviewable annually and payable quarterly in advance. A permit covering part of a quarter shall be pro-rata and shall only be issued when at least one full quarter is also being paid for. A quarter shall begin on the first day of the months of April, July, October and January.
5. To define part quarter it shall be assumed that a month is a four-week period. If applying in the first two weeks of a month, then a full month's charge shall be incurred. If applying in the second two weeks, then the first two weeks will not be charged.
6. The permit will be vehicle specific and will display the vehicle registration number together with the month and year of expiry of the permit. (See specimen permit attached).
7. Failure to display a current permit, or to display the permit on other than the registered vehicle, may lead to a charge being made in accordance with the Articles of the Gedling Borough Council (off street parking places – short stay) Order 2001.
8. Failure to comply with the Articles of the Gedling Borough Council (off street parking places- short stay) Order 2001 may also lead to the withdrawal of parking rights, loss of permit and ineligibility for further issue of a permit for a period of one year.
9. Permits shall not be transferable.
10. Any misuse of the permit or the Car Park may, upon the serving of a Notice, render the permit invalid and no balance of the fee will be repayable.
11. An existing permit holder has the right to renew their permit. If all permits have been issued, any new applicants shall be placed on a waiting list until such time as a permit becomes available.
