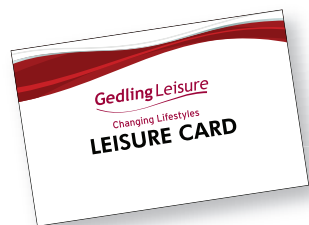


What is the Gedling Leisure Card?

The Gedling Leisure Card is a small swipe card that entitles the cardholder access to leisure facilities at a discounted rate of 15%. The card is available at a nominal fee to both residents and non-residents and is renewable annually.

In some circumstances it may be possible to qualify for a concessionary Gedling Leisure Card, which gives a further discount of up to 50% off leisure activities. The concessionary Gedling Leisure Card is available to:

- Juniors (under 16)
- Students
- People over the age of 60
- People in receipt of certain benefits
- People living with a disability



What are the benefits?

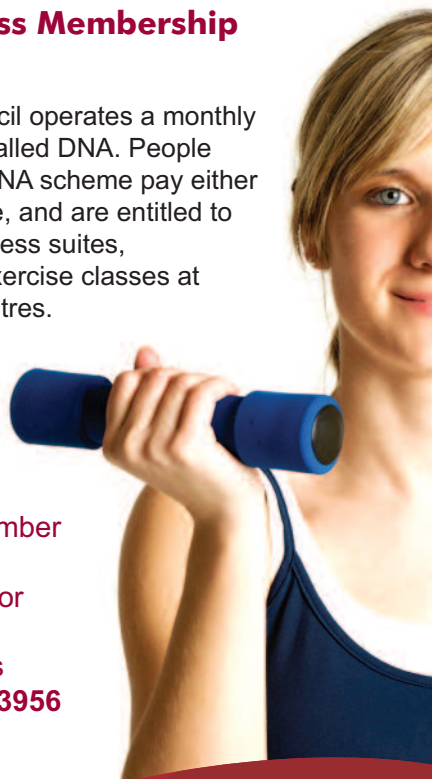
The benefits of having a Gedling Leisure Card are:

- Discounted rates on all activities
- The ability to book activities up to 7 days in advance
- Online booking and cancellation of activities

Health and Fitness Membership Scheme

Gedling Borough Council operates a monthly membership scheme called DNA. People who subscribe to the DNA scheme pay either a monthly or annual fee, and are entitled to unlimited use of the fitness suites, swimming pools and exercise classes at any of the 4 leisure centres.

Terms & conditions

General

1. The Leisure Card is at all times the property of Gedling Borough Council and must be surrendered to the Council on demand. The Leisure Card is annually renewable. See price list for details.
2. The Leisure Card is not transferrable and must be used only by the person for whom it was issued. If transferred it will be forfeited.
3. All changes to personal details must be disclosed to Gedling Borough Council.
4. Gedling Borough Council reserves the right to refuse to issue or renew the Leisure Card
5. The Leisure Card must be available for inspection at any time. If it cannot be produced or is in any way not valid the full price for the activity must be paid without right of refund. If required, customers must sign their name as proof of identity.
6. The Leisure Card photograph must at all times be a true likeness of the holder. In the event of a change in the appearance of the cardholder, the Council reserves the right to request a new photograph to be taken.
7. Any loss of the Leisure Card shall be reported immediately to Gedling Borough Council.
8. Any breach of these conditions will render the Leisure Cardholder liable to forfeiture.
9. Completion and signature of the Leisure Card application form will be held to constitute acceptance of these conditions including requirement for photograph.
10. Concessions may not apply in the following circumstances:
 - i) Group bookings or room hire
 - ii) When a person entitled to the concessionary rates shares an activity with a non-eligible person (i.e. Squash, Badminton bookings)
 - iii) Courses
 - iv) Sports Pitches
 - v) Other items as specified in the published price lists
11. It is essential that you present your card at reception on every visit.
12. Facilities may be withdrawn or restricted from time to time to perform essential repairs and refurbishment, where possible two weeks notice will be given. Other centres in the Borough may provide the same or similar facilities.
13. Sessions may be limited over Christmas and other holiday periods. Please see notices at the time.

14. In order to avoid disappointment please pre-book all sessions, bookings may be made up to 7 days in advance. www.gedling.gov.uk/leisurebookings
15. The minimum age to join the main Fitness Suites and classes is 14 years. The minimum age to join SHOKK Gym and Classes is 8 years.
16. Under 16's may only use the main Fitness Suites before 6.00pm on weekdays and at any time throughout the weekend. At other times they must be accompanied by a responsible adult (over 18 years).
17. Please note under 16's are not permitted to use free weights outside of the SHOKK Gym.
18. Gedling Leisure reserves the right to refuse entry and / or to withdraw membership at any time.
19. Gedling Leisure reserves the right to alter the programme of activities at the Centres.
20. Use is subject to bookings and availability.

Lost, Stolen and Damaged Cards

1. Replacement cards can be purchased from any Leisure Centre. This does not include annual renewals. See Price List for details.
2. If the card needs to be replaced through normal wear and tear then a replacement card will be issued free of charge.

Cancellations

In order to protect access for everyone we require 24 hours notice for cancellation of a booking. We reserve the right to charge the normal standard rate for the booking that is not cancelled. This applies to all categories of membership including DNA. Cancellation can be done online www.gedling.gov.uk/leisurebookings

Crèche

Access to Crèche facilities is strictly limited to those children for whom you have an ongoing parental responsibility.

Carers

Carers of people with disabilities will be admitted free of charge where this is for the purpose of assisting the disabled person.

Refunds

No refunds for Gedling Leisure Cards will be given.

Data Protection
