- Q5. Are the detailed requirements for each of the allocations clear and justified? Have site constraints, development mix and viability considerations been adequately addressed? Are the boundaries and extent of the sites correctly defined? [GVA for Northern Trust]
- Q6. For those sites that have been removed from the Green Belt, have exceptional circumstances been demonstrated to enable the alteration of existing Green Belt boundaries? Have all potential sites in the Green Belt been considered for inclusion based on clear criteria? [Planning and Design Group for Mr Steve Walker]
- Q7. Has full consideration been given to the Human Rights Act when allocating sites in the Plan? [Willow Farm Action Group]
