Policies Map

Issue 17a: Green Belt Boundary

Q1. Should any further changes be made to the Green Belt boundary? If so, what are the exceptional circumstances which justify the changes?

- 17.1 The Policies Map in Part C of the Local Planning Document shows the proposed Green Belt boundary which takes account of all revisions, including the site allocations, safeguarded land, changes to the infill boundary at Lambley and Woodborough and the removal of the existing retention of employment land designation at Hollinwood Lane in Calverton.
- 17.2 Comments received on the Local Planning Document by residents and developers with regarding to the removal of their sites from the Green Belt and the Council's response to the comments are summarised in the Report of Responses (**LPD/REG/04**).
- 17.3 To date, no further changes to the Green Belt boundary have been identified.

Issue 17b: Changes to the Policies Map

Q2. Are any changes required to the Policies Map in response to policy changes?

- 17.4 The Policies Map in Part C of the Local Planning Document shows site allocations and the areas to which site specific policies apply.
- 17.5 Changes have been made to the Policies Map and the details are set out in Revised Schedule of Changes to Local Planning Document Publication Draft (December 2016) (**EX/10A**) – see **MM55**, **MM56** and **MM57** for details and Appendices 1, 2 and 3 for illustrations.
- 17.6 To date, no further changes to the Policies Map have been identified.
