We asked you for any other feedback for us to consider as part of the finalising the plans for the site. Here are the main issues:

- Introduction of new, modern commercial premises will benefit the whole of the town centre and stimulate the local economy
- Investment here will support the market
- The improvements to this part of town are much needed
- Public realm/events space will be a focal point
- Small, starter units will help support local businesses, but these need to be affordable
- Good to have a mixture of uses in the scheme
- Do not need any more retail units in the town centre
- Market key asset and heart of the town needs to be included
- Scheme needs to happen quickly
- Need some good quality public toilet provision in the town centre
- Type of uses within the storage building and appearance to neighbouring residents
