### What is ProHelp?

A national programme which targets areas of deprivation, with a resource of 80 commercial firms and 50 independent business volunteers in the East Midlands comprising of:

## What can ProHelp do?

- Assist with company incorporation
- Help negotiate the terms of a lease
- Develop a Business Plan
- Survey a building
- Produce outline architectural plans and costings
- IT Cost Reduction
- Develop a marketing plan
- Assist with improving accounting systems
- Provide advice & guidance on specific projects & challenges
- Mentor an individual or join board



### **Criteria for Assistance**

- Not-for-profit
- Annual income of <£250k</li>
- No funds available
- Locally constituted
- A specific piece of work
- Realistic and viable
- Not 'regular' work
- Not litigious
- Not urgent!



### What is the process?

- Receipt of application
- Assess suitability
- Request support
- Provide you with an assignment brief and contact details
- One to one consultations or group meetings
- Keep in touch/progress updates
- End of assignment evaluation form and closure letter



### Is this a 'free service'?
