These will all be delivered in early autumn. Additional activities are taking place to prepare for universal credit full service on 14 November 2018. A working group are preparing a partner charter outlining the collaborative approach to be taken to implement uniformed messages about the changes. A claimant checklist on what they need to prepare along with drop-in sessions to support with digital skills.
